THE CITY CLERK: THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE ADOPTED ON FIRST READING, UPON WHICH A HEARING WAS HELD AND CLOSED, IS NOW BEFORE THE COUNCIL FOR CONSIDERATION ON SECOND READING AND FINAL PASSAGE:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DEVOTING THE USE OF THE NEWARK CITY HOSPITAL EXCLUSIVELY TO THE INDIGENT SICK AND DISABLED AND FOR THE NECESSITY OF EMERGENCY AID IN SAID CITY", AND REVISING SECTIONS 9.1 TO 9.7 INCLUSIVE, OF CHAPTER 9 CITY HOSPITAL, REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, 1951, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL FOR THE PUBLIC TREATMENT AND RELIEF OF THE INDIGENT SICK AND INDIGENT INJURED RESIDENTS OF THE CITY AND FOR THE PRIVATE CARE OF OTHER SICK AND INJURED.
